3. EVENT DETAILS

Article 7 – SERVICING AND REFUELLING

7.2 SSkids Tyres in Eudunda has 91 and 95 Unleaded Petrol and Diesel and will be open from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM on Saturday 29th June 2019. SSkid Tyres are located at: 1 Barwell Street, Eudunda SA 5374. See Map at end of Further Regs. The nearest other service stations will be the BP in Kapunda (28km) or United in Truro (30km).

7.3 Servicing and refuelling:
Refuelling is not permitted in service areas, or within Town limits (unless using the pumps at SSkid Tyres). Service Crews are free to refuel cars at other locations on the rally route excluding on Special Stages, however Crews are reminded that **servicing is only permitted in the designated service area at Eudunda Oval.**

Where crews don't have a dedicated Service Crew, crews should arrange to "Buddy Up" with a car near them to help with refuelling. Rallying has always had great camaraderie between crews. If another crew asks if your Service Crew can help them with refuelling, please give them a hand.

Service Crews are reminded that they should ensure a suitable fire extinguisher is carried in the Service Vehicle and that State Legislation limits the amount of fuel which may be carried in vehicles. Rally Crews should have their doors open and seatbelts undone while refuelling. Smoking and the use of Mobile Telephones are prohibited while refuelling.

Article 10 - DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

10.18 Parking is limited at Nisscare for Thursday (27/6) Scrutineering. Crews are asked, where possible, to bring just their rally cars to Scan Court and either leave trailers at home or park trailers some distance away. We appreciate your support in this.



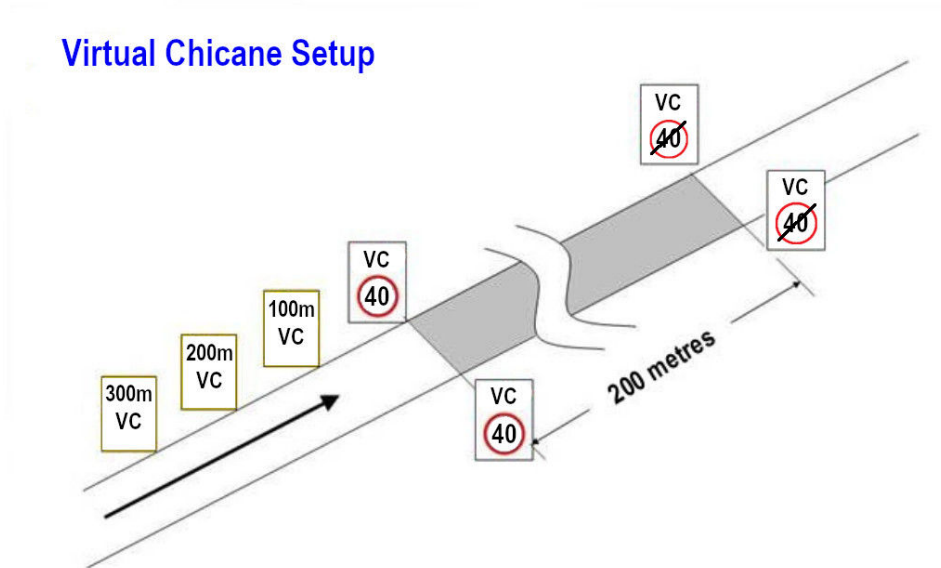
Article 16 - PRIZES, TROPHIES AND AWARDS
