2019 marks the 35th running of the
Walky 100 in the Eudunda/Robertstown Area.

2018 saw the 34rd running of the Robertstown Rally, currently known as the Copyworld Walky 100. It was the 3rd round of the South Australian Rally Championship, and the largest scale event run by the Walkerville All Cars Club Inc.

Article 3 - EVENT DETAILS

- 3.1 The **2019 COPYWORLD Walky 100** will be a round of the MRF Tyres South Australian Rally Championship, run as a **Special Stage Rally** (hereafter referred to as the 'Event'). The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of CAMS, the National Rally Code (NRC), the CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, the 2019 South Australian Conditions of Rallying, the 2019 MRF Tyres SARC Series Regulations, these Event Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins that may be issued.

The Event will be using A to A timing as per National Rally Code NRC EG 1.2(c). Timing will be to the 1/10th second using RallySafe.

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S , CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

- 3.2 Where there is any divergence between the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport (hereafter referred to as the CAMS Manual), the current SA Conditions of Rallying, the current SARC Series Regulations and these Event Supplementary Regulations, the Event Supplementary Regulations, Further Regulations & Bulletins will take precedence.
- 3.3 The CAMS Permit Number authorising the Event is **519/2906/01**, which will be displayed on the Official Notice Board at the Event. Licenced drivers, service crews and all officials must be signed on and, as such, are covered by Personal Accident Insurance under the terms of CAMS.
- 3.4 The length of the rally will be approximately 397 kms, including 12 stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 132 kms. All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held in the Regional Councils of Goyder and Mid Murray, on (closed) public & private roads.
- 3.5 The Event will consist of one Heat on one day.
- 3.6 The Event will use RallySafe for tracking and timing purposes - see article 19.
- 3.7 The Event will use Virtual Chicanes as per the CAMS Manual - see article 17.



Article 5 - CREW ELIGIBILITY

- 5.1 Crews shall comprise of two persons only, both being the holders of a current, relevant CAMS licence. The Driver with a minimum of Clubman Rally and the Co-Driver with a minimum of Clubman Rally (Navigator only). One Crew Member is to be nominated on the Entry Form as Driver and the other member as Co-Driver / Navigator.

Article 6 - ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

- 6.2 Entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The EFT Description / Lodgement Reference **MUST** be specified as the name of the competitor (i.e. **NOT** Copyworld Rally, Walky100 Rally or Walkerville All Cars Club). A written or printed receipt **MUST** be provided with the Entry Form for ease of processing.

Article 7 - SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- 7.1 The maximum distance between nominated Service Parks and refuel zones will be approximately 106 kms (including 35 kms competitive).



7.2 There will be no fuel available during the event.
The nearest service stations will be the BP in Kapunda (28km) or United in Truro (30km).

7.3 Servicing and refuelling:
Refuelling is not permitted in service areas, or within Town limits. Service Crews are free to refuel cars at other locations on the rally route excluding on Special Stages, however Crews are reminded that **servicing is only permitted in the designated service area at Eudunda Oval.**

Where crews don't have a dedicated Service Crew, crews should arrange to "Buddy Up" with a car near them to help with refuelling. Rallying has always had great camaraderie between crews. If another crew asks if your Service Crew can help them with refuelling, please give them a hand.

Service Crews are reminded that they should ensure a suitable fire extinguisher is carried in the Service Vehicle and that State Legislation limits the amount of fuel which may be carried in vehicles. Rally Crews should have their doors open and seatbelts undone while refuelling. Smoking and the use of Mobile Telephones are prohibited while refuelling.

7.10 All Competitors MUST notify the secretary of their location in Service Park. A map will be provided at sign-on to indicate each service crew's location.

Article 8 - RECONNAISSANCE AND PACE NOTING

8.2 Recce speed limits - All road traffic regulations apply with the maximum speed to be the lower of 80 kph or as sign posted on special stages or as sign posted on liaisons.

8.8 Reconnaissance Times - Refer Event Program.

Road Book collection for recce:

- For recce on Sunday 23rd June 2019 - from Rally Office (Ingle Farm) - see Section 1 (Event Program) for dates and times.
- At Scrutineering - Thursday 27th June 2019
- Rally HQ (Eudunda) - Friday 28th June 2019, 08.00 am to 08.30 am (by prior arrangement only).

Article 10 - DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

10.1 Documentation will be available during the following times and must be completed prior to presentation of competition vehicles for Scrutiny:

- Thursday 27th June 2019, 1900 hrs till 2030 hrs at Nisscare, 15 Scan Court, Royal Park, SA 5014. Phone: (08) 8240-0011 **AND**
- Saturday 29th June 2019, 0700 hrs till 0800 hrs at Rally Headquarters, Eudunda Oval.

Competitors are advised to check for details of report times and locations in the Further Regulations.

Food will be available at the Thursday night scrutineering at Nisscare.

ALL SARC Competitors are required to attend local or regional scrutineering for the event.

10.6 Documents to be presented at documentation include:

- CAMS Competition Licence of BOTH crew members
- CAMS Vehicle Log Book in accordance with the Schedule L of the current CAMS Manual
- CAMS Affiliated Club Membership Cards



- Civil Drivers Licence of BOTH crew members (unless Navigator is holder of a 'National Rally Navigator Only' licence and signs a declaration to the effect that they will not drive the car during the event)
- Vehicle Registration Papers / Permit All documents presented must be current & not expire over the duration of the event.

10.17 SARC Competitors are reminded that a Frontal Head Restraint is required in 2019 - see Appendix D in CAMS Manual for revised apparel requirements.

Article 16 - PRIZES, TROPHIES AND AWARDS

- 16.8 The Trophy Presentations, based on provisional results, will be held at 2130 hrs on Saturday 29th June 2019 at Rally Headquarters, Eudunda Oval (or earlier if possible).
- 16.10 Walkerville All Cars Club Inc Member Awards: The "Walky 500 Trophy" shall be presented to the highest placed Crew who are both financial members of the Walkerville All Cars Club Inc (WACC) at the close of entries. The award will be presented at the WACC Annual General Meeting in December.

Article 17 - VIRTUAL CHICANES

- 17.1 There may be several Virtual Chicanes (VC) as defined in section NRC SSR 5.6(a)(iii) of the CAMS Manual.

VC's are points where you will be required to slow to below a nominated speed of 40km/h in a 200m virtual box starting from the point marked on the course with a designated 'VC' board.

The RallySafe system will be used to determine the speed of the vehicle.

1. On approaching the VC, there will be the 300m, 200m, and 100m warning boards.
2. At the VC Start there will be a Board with VC 40 on both sides of the road.
3. Between this point and the next 200m you will need to decrease your speed to 40 km/h or below.
4. As soon as this has been achieved, RallySafe will go Green and you can then accelerate back to competition speed.

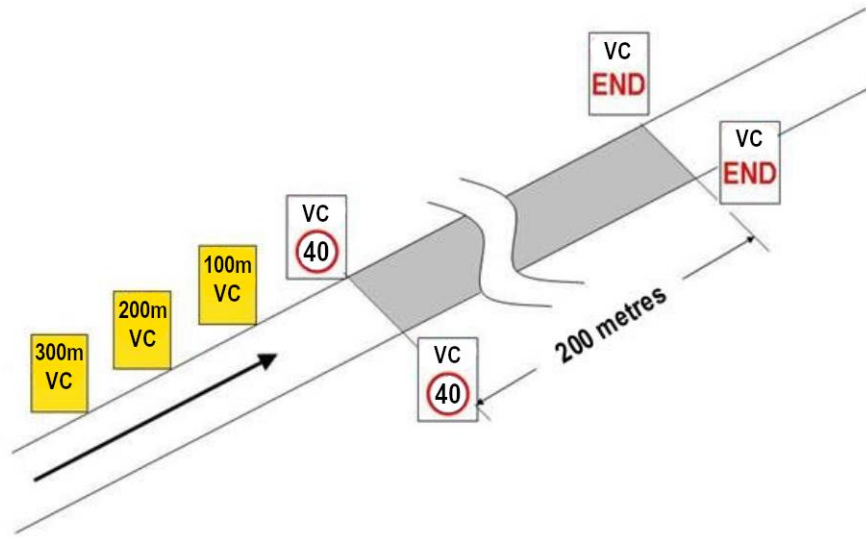

The following penalties will apply for actions within a VC:

1. Reported lowest displayed speed exceeding 40km/h but not exceeding 45km/h - a penalty of 5 seconds.
2. Reported lowest displayed speed exceeding 45km/h but not exceeding 50km/h - a penalty of 15 seconds.
3. Reported lowest displayed speed exceeding 50km/h a penalty of 60 seconds.

The Stewards shall determine such other penalties as may be deemed fit, in addition to the minimum mandatory penalties outlined above.





Article 18 - RESULTS

- 18.3 Provisional and final results will be posted on the official 2019 COPYWORLD Walky 100 Website: <https://walky100.com.au>
- 18.4 Timing will be to the 1/10th of a second and based on RallySafe.

Article 19 - RALLYSAFE

- 19.1 The All competitors must make provision in their competition vehicle for the RallySafe GPS and tracking system.

The RallySafe GPS units and tracking systems will be available at the service park in Eudunda. The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked in Eudunda.

The power supply to the RallySafe unit and the proper connection of all aerials must be continuous from 30 minutes prior to the vehicle leaving the first Time Control of a day until the car reaches the final Time Control of that day or retires from the Event. Interruptions to the power supply or aerial connections or any other misuse of the RallySafe equipment may be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting, who may impose a penalty up to exclusion.

If the unit is damaged whilst in the care of the competitor, then the competitor is responsible to pay for repairs or replacement as necessary. Insurance is available from RallySafe if required. Competitors can insure the RallySafe unit against loss or damage. Further information can be found here: <https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/damage-waivers/>

Competitors are responsible for the return of tracking units immediately after arrival at the final control. It is solely the competitor's responsibility to return the RallySafe tracking unit screen to the RallySafe technician immediately after the event.

Should a competitor retire, they must return the tracking unit to the RallySafe technician in the



Service Park as soon as possible. Competitors are responsible for the return of tracking units to RallySafe representatives or the Rally Office immediately after arrival at the final control or Parc Fermé. **Do not take them home.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
